Where married, the name of the descendant is shown above the black line, the husband or wife beneath, and when known, the year of marriage in brackets (). Divorces have been shown thus *; adoptions *. Where there has been intermarriage of descendants, the names of children have been shown by the father's name only. From what I have been able to gather, the descendants of Robert and Harriet, are residents of all states of Australia except Tasmania, with several in Canada. I have tried to make it current to January 19th, 1969, but it has been very difficult to present an absolutely faultless record with so many people to contact. I can only hope that what is contained within these pages may be of interest and value now, and in the years ahead.

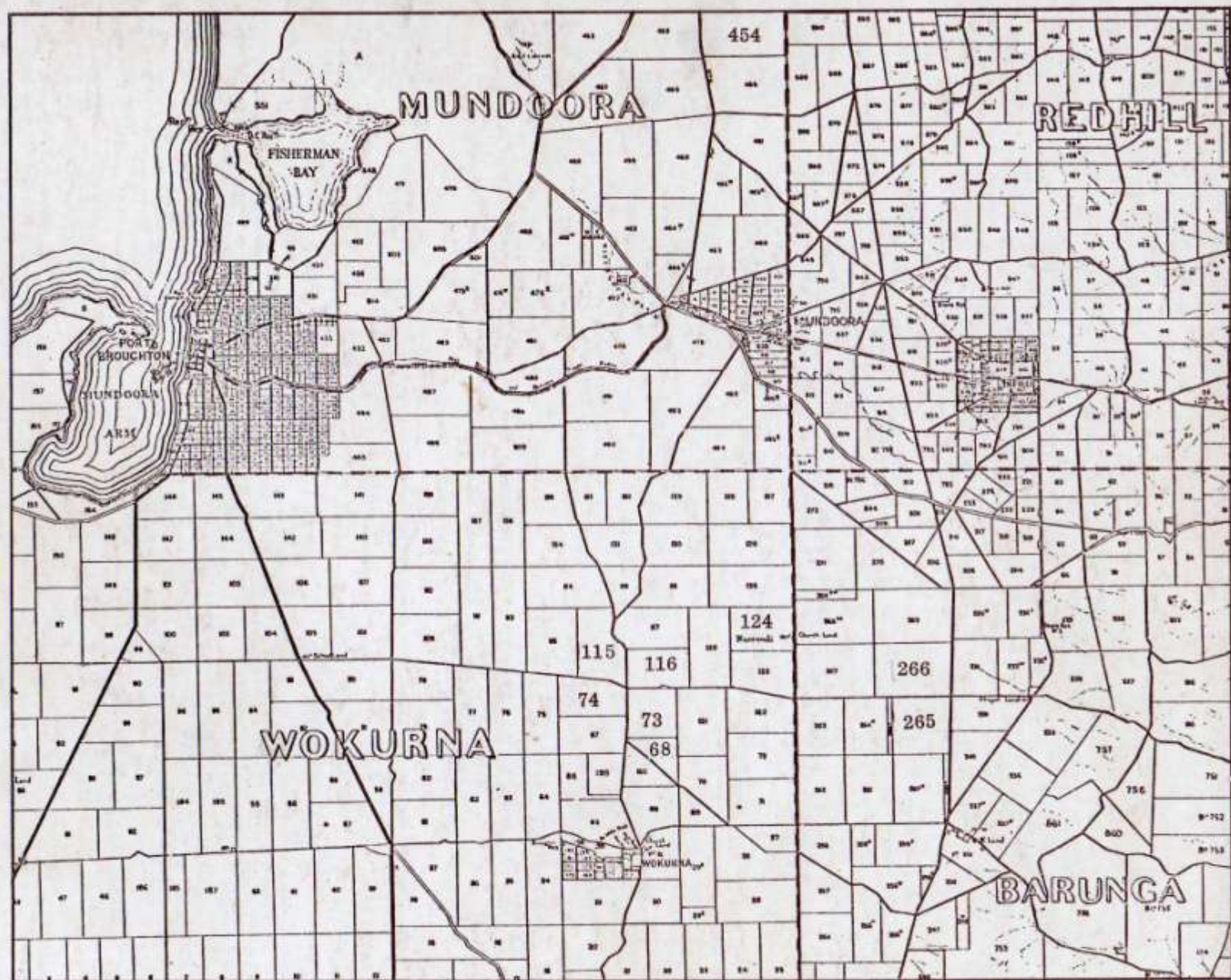

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History of Robert & Harriet

Robert IRELAND was born on June 3rd, and baptised on July 7th, 1833, in the Parish Church of Walton in the county of Somerset, England; the son of Robert Ireland, plasterer and tiler, and Marianne (formerly Mogg).

Harriet JONES was born on December 12th, 1834, and baptism on January 4th, 1835, in the Parish Church of Meare (about 2 miles north of Walton); the daughter of Richard Jones, labourer, and Charlotte (formerly Churches).

Robert and Harriet were married on 24th October, 1852, in the Parish Church of Street (about 1 mile east of Walton, near Glastonbury).

With their baby son, Edward, they departed from Plymouth, bound for South Australia, on 20th September, 1853, aboard the sailing ship the "David Malcolm". In the passenger list for the vessel in the State Archives of South Australia, Robert's occupation is given as "Ploughman". After their arrival on 4th January, 1854, the family settled in the District of Hindmarsh. The following entry appears in the "Adelaide Almanack" 1865-69: "Ireland, Robert, carter, York, District of Hindmarsh". Soon afterwards the family moved to Section 178, Hundred of Upper Wakefield, near Auburn (about 75 miles north of Adelaide). The name "Ireland" appears in the minute books of the Auburn District Council during the 1870's.

In the "Northern Argus", Clare, March 14th, 1871, there was a report from the Police Court, Auburn, at which Robert Ireland appeared before Mr. A. King J. P. He was charged with setting fire on March 13th to two stacks of hay valued at £200, about one and a half miles south of Auburn, the property of Mr. W. Wiles. It was stated that Mr. Wiles had ordered his servant to destroy Robert's pigs, which were continually trespassing on his premises. Robert was reported to have said that "Wiles should suffer for this night". He was committed to take his trial at the next sittings of the Supreme Court, and a report of the Sitting of Wed. May 10th, before Sir R. D.

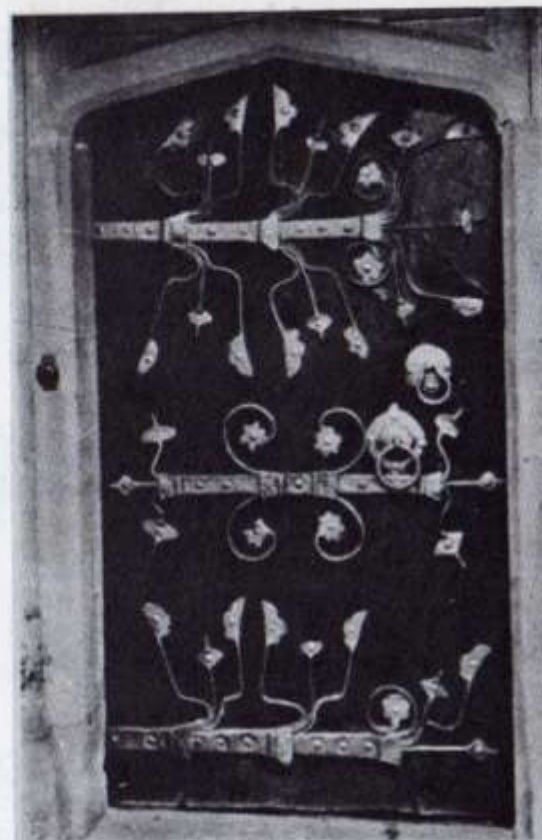

Hanson (Chief Justice) and Juries, appeared in the "South Australian Register" of May 11th, 1871. This was the summary: "His Honor said he did not think there was any case to go to the Jury. - 1.—Her Majesty's Colonial Land and Emigration Commissioners, on the faith that the Statements contained in your Application are in all respects strictly correct, and the Signatures to your Certificates genuine, have directed your Name to be placed on the List of Candidates for a passage to Australia.
- 2.—You must now remit the Sum named in the Letter of Advice on the other side, by Post Office Order, payable at the Post Office, London, to Mr. ALFRED ENGBACH, No. 8, Park Street, Westminster.
- 3.—The Post Office Order must be forwarded to this Office in the printed Letter of Advice hereto annexed. Unless the Letter of Advice be returned, with the Money, an Embarcation Order cannot be issued.
- 4.—Parties living in or near London can, if they desire it, pay their Deposits in Cash to Mr. ENGBACH at this Office, between the hours of 12 and 4. Should money be remitted through Banks, such remittances will be at the risk of the parties making them. Drafts must in these cases be sent, payable at sight to Mr. ALFRED ENGBACH.
- 5.—If you fail to make the payment, it will be considered that you decline to proceed, and your Name will be removed from the Candidates' List.
- 6.—As soon after the money is received as the arrangements of the Office will admit, an Embarcation Order will be sent to you, stating when and where you are to join the Ship, and you are not to leave home until you receive such Embarcation Order, which is not transferable.
- 7.—The Commissioners do not pledge themselves to grant passages in any particular Vessel; but with the view of preventing as far as possible the separation of Families or Friends, Applicants who have been approved for passages, and desire to proceed together, must pay their money at the same time, and state their wishes on the Letters of Advice.
- 8.—The Money will be forfeited if you do not present yourself at the time and place of Embarcation mentioned in the Order, or if any of the Statements in your Application be found incorrect, or the Signatures to your Certificates not genuine, or if deception of any kind be attempted.
- 9.—If, on arrival at the Port of Embarcation, Emigrants are found to have any infectious or contagious disorder, or not to be in a fit state of health to embark, or to have any bodily or mental defect likely to impair their usefulness as laborers, or to have furnished false statements or certificates as to age, character, or ending, or to have left any of their young children behind, or to have brought with them more children than are mentioned in their Application form, or expressly sanctioned by the Commissioners, or to have attempted to practice any evasion of the Regulations, or deception of any kind, or have not the full supply of clothing required by the Regulations, such Emigrants, and the members of their families, whom it would be contrary to the Rules of the Commission to separate, cannot be allowed to proceed, but must return home again at their own expense.
- 10.—Your Certificates are herewith returned.

act. Although there were threats uttered by the prisoner, it was not shown that he was seen in the vicinity of the haystacks at the time the fire broke out, nor was there anything to exclude the possibility that one of fifty other persons might have committed the crime...." The Jury returned a verdict of not guilty, and the prisoner was discharged. This was an extraordinary event in what seems to have been a quiet, hard-working life. Although a verdict of "Not guilty" exempts one from all blame within a court of law, the case probably caused much local comment at the time.

With the increase of the population in South Australia, there came a demand in the 1870's for further sub-division of land for farming purposes. North of Port Wakefield lay the sheep runs of Hummocks, Barunga, Bunnabunga and Wokurna, which totalled an area of 380 square miles, and were described as consisting of "salt lakes and lagoons, dense scrub with mallee, pine and bushes, grassy plains and saltbush, well grassed spurs and hills with oaks and wattle..."

On 3rd September, 1874, Section 266, Hundred of Barunga, containing 601 acres, was offered at auction by the Government. On 21st July, 1875, Robert Ireland signed an agreement (Number 5745, Dept. of Lands) to buy this land. The purchase price was £841-8-0, and Robert paid a deposit of £202-1-0.

In 1877, with their family, Robert and Harriet travelled the 70 miles or so north-west from Auburn to make their home on their selection near the recently established towns of Mundoorra and Port Broughton.

A great number of their descendants still live within a 20 mile radius of Section 266, many of them being farmers. Robert is recalled by his grand-daughter, Mrs.

Ida Inglis, as being small in stature, with golden-auburn hair and of a kindly temperament, being always willing to help others. He was fond of sheep and horses, and had one horse called "Paddy", which when tapped on the knee would enable him to mount more easily. When swagmen called, looking for work, he would offer them a meal. The man who ate a meal quickly and heartily, he believed, would prove a good worker, and could well be employed. Many of his grand-children were christened in the small church (which also served as a school) at Sharp's Well - another name for the part of Barunga in which they lived. Mrs. Inglis recalls the many pleasant tea-meetings which were held in those days in the church which has now been closed for many years. In times of sickness or bereavement friends and neighbours would come and stay the night, or longer, with the troubled family.

After Robert's death in 1894, the following notice appeared in the newspaper:- "IRELAND - On the 10th May, at Barunga, of cancer, Robert Ireland, late of Auburn, aged 61, leaving a widow and 6 sons, 5 daughters and 41 grandchildren to mourn their loss. An old colonist of 41 years. - Asleep in Jesus."

For some time his widow, Harriet, continued to live in their home at Barunga. When her grand-children were visiting her, she would often go down her cellar to bring them a piece of fruit - the memory of which has endured over the years.

In the early 1900's she moved to a small house which had belonged to a Mr. Freeman, on Section 116, Hundred of Wokurna (this section now in the family of her great grand-daughter, Mrs. Maureen Duffield). Harriet's son, John, lived just opposite her, and other children were nearby.

On July 16th, 1906, at the residence of Mr. J. Waters, Waring St., Kadina, Harriet Ireland, 71, Widow, was married to Henry Elder, 71, Widower. It seems to have been an ill-matched union, as he only lived with her a very short time before going away. (It is said that when Harriet realised that he had married her with the hope of financial gain, she soon "despatched" him.)

She died on 28th June, 1911. The following obituary appeared in the newspaper:- "Barunga North, July 12. - A few days ago the death occurred of Mrs. Harriet Elder. She was a colonist of 58 years, was 76 years of age, and left six sons, three daughters, 90 grand-children, and 36 great-grandchildren. Up to the time of her death she was always of a bright and cheerful disposition, and was loved and highly esteemed by all who knew her. The sons and daughters that are still living are:- Messrs. Robert

Ireland, Bute; James Ireland, Mundoora; Alfred Ireland, Lincolnsfield; George Ireland, Mundoora; John Ireland, Barunga North; Ernest Ireland, Barunga; Mrs. John Stringer, Barunga; Mrs. William Stringer, Mundoora; and Mrs. Dunning, Barunga North."

Harriet was laid to rest in the Keilli Cemetery, beside Robert. The following inscription was made on their tombstones:-

This is the last will and testament of me Robert Ireland Senior of the Hundred of Barunga County of Daly in the Province of South Australia Farmer Firstly I desire that all my just debts Funeral Testamentary expenses be paid and satisfied by my Executors hereinafter named as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and the money required to discharge same to be taken out of my personal estate after this is done by my said Trustees I give devise and bequeath to my wife Harriet Ireland for her own use and benefit all interest due on money invested or interest due by Bank and all money in my current account at Bank or money in my house or about my person at the time of my decease also all wheat stored in my name or on my premises at the time of my decease Secondly I give to my Trustees to hold in Trust for my Wife and Family all my land houses horses implements household furniture and money invested of which I may be possessed at the time of my decease And desire my Trustees to allow my said wife Harriet the use of the said land houses horses implements and to pay to my said wife Harriet annually all interest or money invested during her natural life Thirdly on the decease of my said wife Harriet I give devise and Bequeath to my son Earnest Ireland all my interest in that section of land (no. 266) Two hundred and sixty six Hundred of Barunga and should my son Alfred William Ireland have attained the age of twenty one years before my decease I give my said son Alfred William all my interest in that section of land (74) seventy four Hundred of Wokurna and I direct my Trustees give him the title of the said land as soon as conveniently after my decease And if my said son Alfred William be not of the age of twenty one years at the time of my decease I direct

my Trustees to hold the said land until he reaches the said age and all rent collected from said section I desire my Trustees to pay to my wife Harriet until my said son reaches the age of Twenty one years Fourthly And as to the rest and residue of my real and personal estate on the decease of my wife Harriet I direct my Trustees to sell by Public auction and to collect all sums of money which may be due to my Estate and after payment of all expenses to divide the proceeds equally between eleven of my children their heirs administrators and assigns Edward, Eliza Jane, Robert, Ann, Harriet, John, Emily, James, Alfred William, George and Rhoda Fifthly and I nominate constitute and appoint Joseph Turner of Snowtown Storekeeper and Robert Ireland Junior of Barunga Farmer to be Executors of my Will and hereby revoke all former wills made by me at any time heretofor and I declare this to be my last Will and Testament

Official government registration of births, marriages and deaths did not begin in England until July, 1837 (in South Australia not until July, 1842). Ilchester, Street, Walton and Meare are all towns in the county of Somerset, England.

EDWARD IRELAND

was born on February 18th, 1853, at Street, Somerset, England, and baptised in the parish church on March 12th by Richard Nicholson Wood, the curate. On September 20th of the same year Edward departed with his parents for South Australia aboard the "David Malcolm". Soon after the family moved from Auburn to Barunga, Edward went to the north of the State. On 14th October, 1880, at the residence of the bride's father, Melrose, he married Jane, daughter of Mr. James BROWN. They lived on their farm which was situated in the now famous scenic region of the Flinders Ranges between Hawker and Wilpena Pound (section 129, Hundred of Arkaba, County of Hanson; now part of the property "Arkaroola", belonging to his grandson, Frank). Edward also conducted the Wilpena Mail Service.

After being thrown while trying to break-in a horse which no one else would attempt to ride, Edward developed inflammation of the lungs and died on July 10th, 1888. He was laid to rest in the Hawker Cemetery. Jane, left with four young sons, later married a Mr. Parker, but he died shortly afterwards, while she lived on at Hawker until her death in 1937. The three eldest sons had moved to properties in N.S.W., while the youngest remained at Hawker.

THE SECOND CHILD

was born on October 5th, 1854, the year of her parents' arrival in South Australia. The book-plate of her Bible attests: "Annual Reward, Presented to Eliza Ireland by the Primitive Methodist Sunday School, Beverley, as a token of esteem". She moved to Auburn with her family, and married Thomas Henry, son of Mr. George SUMMERTON, of Auburn. They also moved to Keilli, near Mundoora and Barunga. The following newspaper report appeared after the death of their son George, in 1890: "Redhill, July 28, A lad named Summerton, aged 12 years, living at Keilli, met his death yesterday while balancing himself on the back of a spring cart in which was a bag of flour, the cart tipped up, knocking the boy to the ground. He fell on the back of his head and was killed instantly. His father was close at hand when the accident happened." A total of three sons and ten daughters were born (three sets of twins). Eliza died on April 17th, 1895, following the birth of Ada. The children were cared for by relatives and friends. Henry died in 1928 and was buried beside his wife in the Keilli Cemetery.

THE THIRD CHILD

ROBERT IRELAND

was born on January 14th, 1860, at Kilkenny. At the age of 11 he went with his parents to live at Auburn. Six years later they removed to Barunga. On October 19th, 1882, at the residence of the bride's father, he was married to Mary Ann, eldest daughter of Mr. Francis RATCLIFF of Barunga, by the Rev. W. Isaac. Two sons and seven daughters were born during the following twenty-four years, while Robert was farming at Barunga. He then moved to a farm at Lincolnsfield, near Bute. On March 8th, 1927, he died (of cancer). His widow lived on the farm with their son, Robert, for many years, but spent her later years with her daughter, Fanny (Mrs. Tom McDonald) at Ward's Hill, near Port Broughton. She died in 1946, and is buried beside her husband in the Kadina Cemetery.

ANN IRELAND

was born on September 29th, 1861 at Hindmarsh. She moved with her parents to Auburn and Barunga. On February 25th, 1880, at the residence of her father, she was married to John, eldest son of Mr. Stephen STRINGER of Barunga, by the Rev. F. Bullock. Six sons and eight daughters were born of this union. John and Ann made their home on Section 265, Hundred of Barunga (now the property of their grandson, Ashley Stringer), just opposite Ann's parents. After farming there for 41 years, they retired to Port Broughton. John died in 1921, and Ann in 1927. The following is an extract from a newspaper obituary: "Mrs. Stringer, widow of Mr. John Stringer, whose death occurred at her residence Harvey Street, Port Broughton, on November 23rd at the age of 66, was highly respected by a large circle of friends". She was buried beside her husband in the Keilli Cemetery.

THE FIFTH CHILD

JOHN IRELAND

was born on July 19th, 1863, at Hindmarsh. He accompanied his parents to Auburn and Barunga. Moving just a few miles from them, in 1884 he took possession of Section 115, Hundred of Wokurna (a perpetual lease) and built a small hut on the uncleared land which was still occupied by aborigines (this section of 444 acres is now owned by his son, Jim). On November 19, 1885, at the Wesleyan Church, Hoyleton, he was married to Sarah ANN, daughter of Mr. Henry OVERALL and Martha (nee Churches). There were nine sons and four daughters born of this marriage (one set of twins). On January 30th, 1924, his wife died. While overseas on active service during W.W.1, his nephew Vic. Ireland, met and married a Miss Maggie ('Pearl') Park of Wishaw, Scotland. Her widowed mother, Mrs. Margaret Harper Park (nee McGraw), emigrated to S.A., and she and John were married in 1926. She died on September 8th, 1941, aged 74 years, while John lived on until June 25th, 1956. He was buried beside Sarah Ann and Margaret in the Keilli Cemetery.

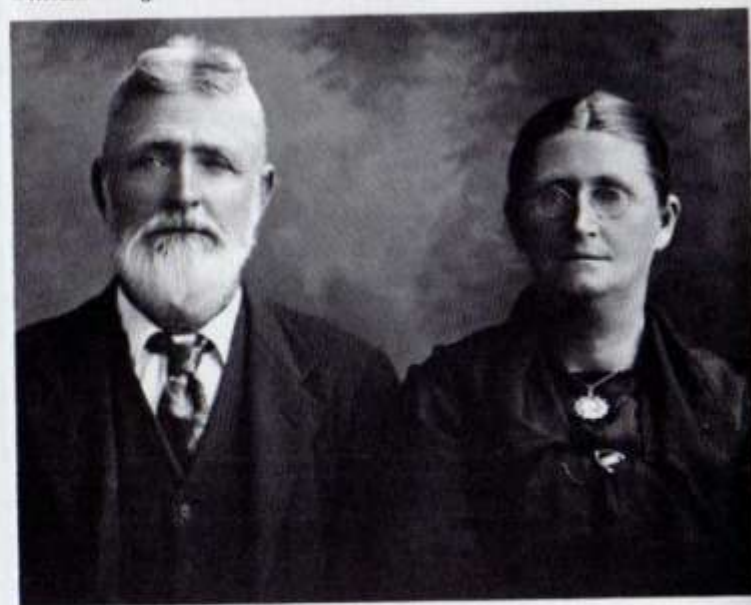

was born on May 7th, 1865 at Hindmarsh. She accompanied her parents to Auburn and Barunga. On October 16th, 1883, at the house of her father, she was married to William, second son of Mr. Stephen STRINGER, by the Rev. James Goodman Martin. The witnesses were Thomas Carman, Wheelwright of Keilli and her father. Seven sons and six daughters were born during the following twenty four years. Harriet and William lived on their farm (Section 124, Hundred of Wokurna - about 5 miles south of Mundoorra, now belonging to their grandson, Kevin Kerley). Harriet died on December 21st, 1932, and William on June 11th, 1943. They are buried in the Keilli Cemetery.

THE SEVENTH CHILD

JAMES IRELAND

was born on March 20th, 1867. After his parents moved to Barunga, he worked for a time with his brother, Edward, at Hawker. On April 9th, 1889, at the Baptist Church, Wokurna, he was married to Ellen, the daughter of Mr. Edward ARBON of Barunga, by the Rev. E. J. Henderson. There were six sons and three daughters

born of this marriage. Their youngest daughter recalls her mother's great pleasure at playing the piano. James farmed for a time at Wokurna, later moving to Bews and finally Clement's Gap (Section 454 Hundred of Mundoora, now farmed by his son, Clem). Retiring from the farm, they went to live in Gawler, where James died on May 14th, 1941. Ellen died on December 11th, 1948. They are buried in the Willaston (Gawler) Cemetery.

EMILY JANE IRELAND

was born on January 28th, 1871. She moved with her parents to Barunga from Auburn. Report has it that when her father was unable to pay a workman, Mr. Francis, he offered him Emily instead. She, however, was most unwilling, and the rejected suitor was later admitted to a mental asylum. On January 22nd, 1890, in the Bible Christian Church, Sharp's Well, Emily married the man

of her choice. He was Henry, fourth son of Mr. Edward ARBON of Wokurna. They lived on a farm between Mundoora and Port Broughton. As the result of an accident caused by their young daughter, their house was burnt. On 26th October, 1899, Emily died of influenza, an epidemic of which was raging at the time. Her two sons also died within a few weeks. The three daughters were cared for by friends and relatives, and Henry later remarried to a Mrs. Lavina Walding, having more children by this marriage.

ALFRED WILLIAM IRELAND

was born on October 16th, 1872, at Auburn, and moved with his parents to Barunga. On July 6th, 1897, he was married to Ellen Sophia CROUCH. In the following twenty-three years ten sons and two daughters were born. They also cared for their niece, Rose Summerton, following the death of her mother. Alfred farmed Section 74, Hundred of Wokurna. From there he shifted to Lincolnsfield, near Bute. Later he went to Bow Hill, near Mannum; and Langhorne Creek. His wife died in 1940. After several years in the Murray Bridge Hospital he died in the Adelaide Hospital in 1959, and was buried beside his wife in the Strathalbyn Cemetery.

On March 30th, 1899, at the Bible Christian Church, Sharp's Well, he was married to Henrietta MARKS (niece of Ellen Crouch). Six sons and seven daughters were born of this marriage. George farmed on Sections 68 & 73, Hundred of Wokurna (535 acres), but after some years, ill health caused him to sell his land (to his brother, John - now in the estate of John's son, Frank). George went to live in Mundoora. During a visit in 1948, to some of his family in Western Australia, he died on December 7th., and was buried in the Keller-berrin Cemetery. His wife at the present is the only surviving marriage partner of Robert & Harriet's children.

was born at Auburn on April 22nd, 1876. In the following year he moved with his parents to Barunga. As the youngest son, he was the beneficiary of his father's homestead section (Number 266, Hundred of Barunga, now owned by his son, Vince). He was married to Cecilia Maude, daughter of Mr. Friedrich DOLLING, on October 7th, 1903, at the Snowtown Methodist Church. Two sons and three daughters were born of this marriage. He continued to farm his land until 1927, when he retired to Port Broughton. Although he underwent an operation for cancer of the bowel, with his walking stick and his cheery word, he was a well known identity of the town for many years, being conversant on topics of local interest until the last. His wife died on November 10th, 1967, and he twelve months later, on November 7th, 1968. They are buried in the Port Broughton Cemetery.

After her death in the Maitland Hospital on March 11th, 1965, she was buried in the Moonta Cemetery.

Mary Ann IRELAND, the witness at Robert's wedding in 1852, was his sister. She was born at Aschott, Somerset, in 1831. Her parents moved to Street, where she was employed as a boot and shoe binder ("Clarks" shoes are made there). On 4th October, 1853, she was married to George BADMAN, of Overleigh, Street, in the parish church. With their sons, Robert and James, they sailed from Bristol, England on 10th March, 1857, aboard the "Gilmore". They landed at Port Adelaide on 4th July, 1857. The family went to live on Eyre Peninsula, west of Port Lincoln, where in the parish of Gum Flat, John, Joseph and Sarah Jane were baptised by the Missionary Chaplain, Basil Craig, on 17th April, 1864. They took up land at Saddleworth for a time, but in 1874 selected three sections of land at Yacka. During the 1880's the brother and sister (Robert from Barunga, and Mary Ann from Yacka) with their families used to meet at the Snowtown Show, there being much friendly rivalry to see who was the best "turned out" with fastest horses and best equipage. It is said that when very ill Mary Ann kept knocking against the wall by her bed. After her death on January 17th, 1890, the family removed some of the plaster from the wall, and found that she had concealed money there. George is remembered by some of his nephews and nieces as a visitor to his widowed sister-in-law, Harriet. He died on 8th August, 1905.
